Funding landholders to reconnect and restore Wet Tropics forests

WHAT IS IT?

Green Connections is a new \$2 million project funded by the Queensland Government's Natural Resource Management Expansion Program.

The goal of the project is to reconnect and buffer large areas of habitat in the Wet Tropics region. It will focus on 11 ecological corridors and strategic rehabilitation areas.

Grant funding is available for eligible revegetation or restoration projects.

WHAT IS ELIGIBLE?

- Eligible activities for funding include; revegetation, assisted natural regeneration, weed and pest control.
- This can include up to 3 years of maintenance.
- Funded works should be on private property.
- Funded works can be undertaken by the landholder and/or a contractor.
- We would prefer large-scale integrated projects more than smaller isolated ones.

WHAT'S THE PROCESS?

- An initial Expression of Interest (EOI) is required.
- These will be assessed and prioritised. We may contact you for more information if necessary.
- We will work with successful applicants on a detailed project plan and funding agreement.
- Timing: Agreements need be finalised this calendar year with on-ground works underway in 2026.
- On one site, we need 0.5 hectares of revegetation completed by December this year.
- Further funding rounds may be available depending on available funds.
